## Genesee School District Vision

## Goals

1. Increase Michigan Educational Assessment Program (MEAP) scores until 90% of our students are proficient on the state language arts and math tests

Strategies:

1. Align and map local curriculum to the state curriculum
2. Improve the quality of instruction

2. Maintain and increase student population by 3% each year until we reach a student population of 900.

Strategies:

1. Develop a school district marketing plan
2. Increase pride in the district

3. Increase community involvement until we have the community participating in activities at school at least two days or nights a week. We will have a 30% increase in community member participation in our daily education program.

Strategies:
